<u>DECIDUOUS TREES & SHRUBS</u>		
HYBRID POPLAR (12-24" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Grows approximately 50'. Spreads 30'. A fast growing tree with large leaves giving lots of shade in a hurry. Soil adaptable.	_____	\$ _____
HIGHBUSH CRANBERRY (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Grows to 8'. Attractive foliage turns red and orange in the fall. Flat clusters of white flowers followed by red berries.	_____	\$ _____
RED OSIER DOGWOOD (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Grows 7-9'. Spreads 8-12'. A broad erect grower with dark blood red branches. White flowers followed by white berries. Good for soil erosion & wildlife food & cover.	_____	\$ _____
WHITE BIRCH (9-14" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Grows 40-60'. Decorative tree, forming a broad, spreading crown. Grows well in flood plains, as well as adjacent upland sites.	_____	\$ _____
OAK – SWAMP WHITE (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Moderate growing tree reaches 50'-60' height. Does well in moist to wet soils and in upland areas. Dark green leaves turn yellow & purple in fall. Sweet acorns.	_____	\$ _____
OAK – RED (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 A wide, massive 80-90' shade tree. Fast growing and long-lived oak. This acorn tree provides food and shelter for wildlife and can tolerate city conditions.	_____	\$ _____
SUGAR MAPLE (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Height 100'. Slow to medium growth. Dark green leaves turn yellow to orange to fiery red in fall. Grows in most soil types. Sap used in maple syrup.	_____	\$ _____
SILVER MAPLE (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Grows to 60'. Very hardy, easy to grow tree, and will tolerate a wide variety of soils. Good tree to grow where few others will survive. Fast growing.	_____	\$ _____
HAZEL NUT (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Small shrub often in clumps reaching 12' in height. Edible brown nuts. Grows best in moist, well-drained soils but will adapt to most types of soils. Full sun or deep shade. Attracts wildlife such as deer, grouse, turkeys, pheasants, & quail.	_____	\$ _____
AMERICAN PLUM (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Grows 15-20'. Small tree or large shrub. White flowers in early May. Edible fruits – red or yellow. Very hardy & drought resistant. Excellent for wildlife plantings.	_____	\$ _____
BLACK CHERRY (12-18" Seedling) 25/\$23.00 Hardy, large tree with rough, dark brown bark. Leaves are oblong with white flowers in late May. Fruit bearing. Grows to approximately 80' tall & 50' wide.	_____	\$ _____

NORWAY RED PINE (7-15" Transplant) **25/\$23.00** _____ \$ _____

 Grows over 35'. Rapid growing tree with 4-6" long, glossy-green needles.
 Uses include timber, windbreak & ornamental. Does well in sandy, dry soil.

WHITE PINE (6-12" Transplant) **25/\$23.00** _____ \$ _____
Buy in lots of 100 and save!!* *100/\$84.00** _____ \$ _____
 Grows over 35'. Fast growing with long, soft bluish-green needles. Uses include
 timber, windbreak & ornamental. Tolerates shade and grows well in sandy and other soils.

NORWAY SPRUCE (7-15" Transplant) **25/\$23.00** _____ \$ _____
Buy in lots of 100 and save!!* *100/\$84.00** _____ \$ _____
 Grows over 35'. Fastest growing spruce with dark green needles and draping
 branches. Good ornamental or windbreak tree. Grows well in most conditions.

WHITE SPRUCE (7-15" Transplant) **25/\$23.00** _____ \$ _____

 Moderate growing tree with bluish-green needles, and short, dense branches.
 Does best in heavy, moist soil. (Deer do not prefer this one)

EASTERN ARBORVITAE (12-16" Transplant) **25/\$23.00** _____ \$ _____
Buy in lots of 100 and save!!* *100/\$84.00** _____ \$ _____
 (White Cedar) Fan-like glossy leaves provide year-round color. Forms a wind tight
 barrier when used for screening or as hedging. Prefers heavy damp areas.

COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE (12-16" Transplant) **25/\$23.00** _____ \$ _____
Buy in lots of 100 and save!!* *100/\$84.00** _____ \$ _____
 Grows over 35'. Densely formed tree with stiff, silvery-blue to bluish-green needles.
 Thrives in dry, well-drained soil.

AMERICAN TAMARACK (12-18" Seedling) **25/\$23.00** _____ \$ _____
Buy in lots of 100 and save!!* *100/\$84.00** _____ \$ _____
 A medium-sized tree, 40-80' tall, open pyramidal crown & shallow wide-spreading
 root system. Best growth in moist areas & better-drained uplands. Needles turn
 fiery orange & yellow in fall before dropping. Deciduous conifer.
